



Wisconsin Chapter Awards Program Information



John W. Curtis Chapter Service Award

- Purpose** This award recognizes outstanding individual achievement through chapter activity and service to the Wisconsin Chapter while supporting the Association's strategic plan, goals, and objectives.
- Eligibility** Individual and corporate candidates must be active members of APWA and actively involved at the chapter level for an extended period of time.
- Selection** Selection is based upon a pattern of activities that have resulted in the enhancement of the quality, efficiency, or cost-effectiveness of services provided by individuals or public agencies. The Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner(s). The committee may, at its discretion, select multiple candidates if the committee determines more than one candidate is equally deserving of recognition.
- Nomination Process** Nominations must be made by members of the Wisconsin Chapter. Submittals should detail the nominee's activity within the chapter and community. Original submittal should include nomination form and documentation supporting the purpose of the award and the award's eligibility requirements. - Deadline** January 31, Annually
- Presentation** The award shall be made by a representative of the Wisconsin Chapter Executive Board at a meeting of the City's/County's governing body. The winner is also recognized at the Spring Conference of the Wisconsin Chapter of APWA and will be featured in the chapter newsletter.
