# Public Access to Your Facilities

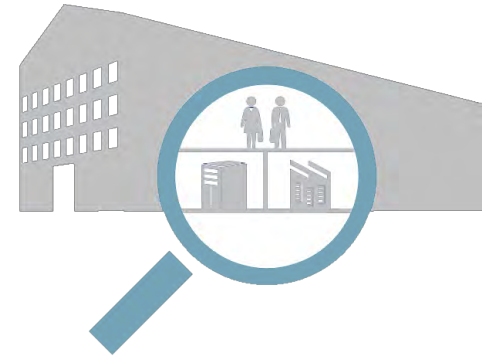


- Have you limited or restricted access to your facilities?

# Staffing Levels Due to COVID-19

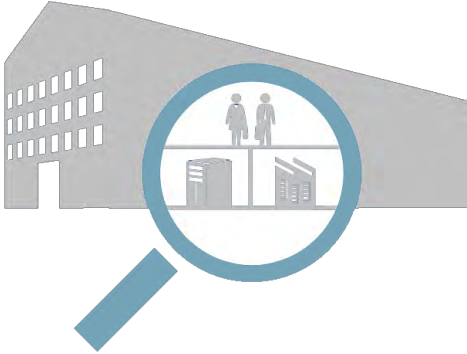


- Positive tests or quarantined employees, what are you doing to maintain service levels?
