### **PARK TRADE TECHNICIAN**

The Department of Public Works is currently accepting applications for the position of Park Trade Technician within the Parks Division. The purpose of this position is to perform semi-skilled and manual labor performing & leading the work on parks maintenance equipment, buildings, grounds, and operations, working either independently or collectively, and to perform related work as required.

Qualified candidates will have experience in:

- Repair and maintenance of buildings and recreational areas;
- Masonry, plumbing, painting, playground and carpentry related maintenance and miscellaneous construction tasks;
- Maintenance of mechanical equipment such as pumps, heaters, boilers, fans; buildings, swimming pools, grounds and tree equipment;
- Operation of tractors, mowers, power saw, trucks, refuse trucks, loaders, boats, backhoe, compressors, trucks and snowplows, aerial lift truck, oxygen-acetylene welding equipment, boilers;
- Aquatics facility operations and systems;
- Maintenance of playground equipment, shelters, tables, benches, signs, doors, and windows;
- Excavation, general concrete work;
- Snow and ice control and removal;
- Buildings construction and maintenance; and
- Lawn care to include trimming trees and other foliage and shrubbery; weeds and flowers.

Graduation from high school or equivalent along with three years of experience in facility maintenance work is required along with certifications in CPR/First aid, and ability to work in confined spaces. Desirable is experience in the operation of forklifts and chain saws.

Special requirements include possession of a valid Wisconsin Commercial Driver's License with B, C, D and Endorsement N, air brakes; certification for Swimming Pool Operation within 12 months.

Starting hourly wage is \$21.60 - \$22.83. A comprehensive benefit package includes health, dental, life, deferred compensation, and Wisconsin Retirement.
