



Wastewater Superintendent City of Fond du Lac

The City of Fond du Lac is accepting applications for the position of **Wastewater Superintendent**. This full-time position will supervise, direct and coordinate various operations of the Fond du Lac Wastewater Treatment & Resource Recovery Facility (WTRRF), wastewater collection lift stations, and plant personnel under the administrative direction of the Director of Public Works. A primary goal is to meet the plant effluent permit discharge requirements and operate the facility in an energy efficient, safe, and cost-effective manner.

Various duties include: Supervising and directing the operations and maintenance of the wastewater treatment facility and remote pumping stations - ensuring that limits and requirements of the discharge permit are met; coordinating the activities of the operations, maintenance and laboratory supervisors; attending Public Works staff meetings and maintaining open lines of communication between City leadership and WTRRF staff; establishing and maintaining positive relationship with Wisconsin DNR; ensuring all plant processes are optimized for plant efficiencies in operations, and compliance with monthly DMR results and annual CMAR results.

Responsibilities include: Supervising Assistant Superintendent, Plant Maintenance Foreman and Lab Coordinator; establishing priorities, preparing estimates and other research required to prepare the annual budget; ensuring that all personnel comply with procedures specified in the City Safety Policy; and completing and submitting the Compliance Maintenance Annual Report and Tier II chemical reports.

Requirements include a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Chemistry, Biology, or a related field, with five years' wastewater treatment experience; and supervisory experience. Must have Wisconsin (WDNR grade 4) Wastewater Treatment Plant Operators License with subgrades A, C, E, F,G, I.

The City of Fond du Lac offers a benefit package including health and life insurance. Starting salary will range from \$84,550 - \$89,380 based upon qualifications. Application deadline is Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at 4:00 p.m.
