Plant Operator (Maintenance)

The Village is seeking applications for the position of Plant Operator (Maintenance) for the Water and Wastewater Utility.

The successful candidate will perform a variety of tasks pertinent to preventative and corrective maintenance and repairs on wastewater treatment plant equipment including: HVAC, electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic and plumbing related equipment and controls. These duties include but are not limited to:

- Lubrication, adjustment and repair of wastewater pumps, gear drives, compressors and motors
- Maintenance, adjustment and repair of facility HVAC systems and related equipment
- Perform routine and corrective maintenance to UV system, anaerobic digester equipment, wastewater sampling equipment and chemical feed pumps
- Maintain and repair WWTP electrical panels, motor control centers, switch gear, etc.
- Thorough knowledge of equipment, facilities, materials, methods, and procedures used in the operations and maintenance of public wastewater treatment and sewer collection systems; water supply and distribution systems, and the ability to perform necessary maintenance and repairs of those facilities and systems.
- Ability to read, follow and comprehend electrical wiring diagrams, ladder diagrams and schematics.
- Working knowledge of rules and regulations which affect Utility operations and activities.
- Skill in operation of the various job-related power and hand tools and equipment.
- Ability to handle a variety of duties without close supervision.
- Ability to interpret technical manuals of operation, standard operating procedures, equipment specifications and technical bulletins.
- Demonstrate working knowledge of SCADA and PC computer equipment with proficient use of current productivity software such as MS Excel, Word, Outlook, etc.
- Certification or strong interest in achieving certification as licensed State of WI Wastewater Operator and Municipal Water Supply Operator desirable.

The candidate shall possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent and supplemented by two (2) years of college or vocational training in one or more of the following areas of study: facilities or industrial maintenance, HVAC and refrigeration, electro-mechanical wiring, electrical or plumbing apprenticeships, boiler operation or maintenance. Course work in environmental sciences, water & wastewater treatment/operations, or a closely related field. Any equivalent combination of education and experience.

Special Consideration:

Special consideration will be given to applicants who meet the Desired Minimum Qualifications and have Wisconsin Firefighter 1 certification. Consideration will also be given to applicants that possess current Emergency Medical Technician Basic certification.
