

Seasonal Public Works/Parks Maintenance Crew Member

The Town of Ledgeview, Brown County, Wisconsin (population 8,444 and growing) is accepting applications for a Seasonal Public Works/Park Maintenance Crew Member to assist full time staff with various Public Works/Parks activities from May through September. Consider how you could contribute to a growing community and be a part of a team that is on the edge of something new!

The position duties and responsibilities include mowing operations, trimming and landscaping, building and grounds maintenance, athletic field maintenance, vehicle maintenance and cleaning, utility, minor sidewalk and roadway maintenance, brush and tree removal, and other related work.

Requirements include: 18 years of age upon first day of employment; a high school diploma or GED; valid WI Driver's License with a good driving record. The ideal candidate would also possess general knowledge of buildings, grounds and equipment maintenance procedures; ability to operate hand/power tools, brush chipper, zero-turn lawnmower, line trimmer, utility vehicles, pickups, and trailers; ability to perform manual labor in all types of weather conditions.

This is a seasonal position, scheduled for 40 hours per week, May through September. Starting pay for this position is \$12/hour with no benefits. Hours of operation are Monday – Thursday 6:30AM – 3:30PM, Fridays 6:30AM – 10:30AM. Preference may be given to candidates living within reasonable distance from the Town.
